You can apply if you meet the following conditions:

- You are a resident of Allegheny or Washington County
- You have a satisfactory criminal background check
- You meet established income guidelines

The grant provides intensive support to help eliminate barriers to your success, such as assistance with child care, tuition and transportation.

During the study, all eligible applicants will be selected by lottery to participate in these training opportunities.
