Who?

Any current PPS students attending a grade K-11

What?

K-7: Participants will receive a combined 3 hours of academic instruction with 2 hours of enrichment activities and a designated block for social-emotional learning

8-11: Participants will receive a combined 2 hours of academic instruction, a block designated for social-emotional learning, and an opportunity to engage in afternoon college or career readiness programming with community providers

When?

Both programs will run Monday-Thursday, from June 22 - August 4

K-7: 9:00am – 4:00pm

8-11: 9:00am – 12:30pm

Where?

The program will be taking place in-person across a number of regional sites. Because of limited capacity in buildings, site placements will be informed by a number of factors including a child's school, home address, proximity to transportation routes, and classroom capacity. Site placements are anticipated for June
